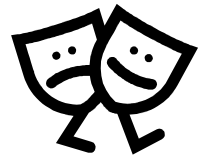




2011 Summer Programs for Children & Teens

ABOUT THE INSTRUCTOR: Dianne O'Neill is a drama educator with over forty year's experience. She has taught and directed students of all ages in her native Australia, in England, in Canada, and for the last twenty five years, in the U.S. She has worked primarily with Middle School students, directing over thirty five Middle School productions at Brunswick School and Greenwich Academy in Greenwich CT, and at Doane Stuart School in Albany NY. Her students have won many awards in Australia including regional drama competitions, one for a play written by the students. Dianne has a Secondary Teacher's Certificate (Arts and Crafts) from Melbourne College, a B.A. (Fine Arts) from the University of Fairfield and an M.A. (Theater) from Sarah Lawrence College. (Majoring in acting and writing, her thesis was a one woman show about five Australian women, which she wrote and performed, it has since been performed at the New York Fringe and at New Jersey Repertory Company in Long Branch NJ.) She majored in dressmaking at Melbourne College and taught dressmaking for several years, and has costumed hundreds of shows including all the shows she directed in Schools and many shows in Community Theater, including several recently for Home Made Theater.
