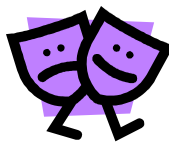


ABOUT THE DIRECTOR

Laurie Larson has a vocal performance degree and minor in theater and dance from Ithaca College, an education degree from SUNY Potsdam and a Masters degree in Theater from SUNY Albany. She is active in community theater and professional theaters as a performer and director for local theaters such as Home Made Theater, Schenectady Light Opera, Albany Civic and Park Playhouse. In 2001, she won a TANYS award for Albany Civic’s production of WORKING and another last year for her performance in BAT BOY. Her most profound personal performance achievement was in 1998 when she was selected for Who’s Who in New Theater Talent Cabaret performance at Lamb’s Theater in New York City. While in New York, she had the opportunity to work with musical theater greats Dennis Buck (42nd Street), Alan Langdon, Bill Reed, and Marnie Nixon (West Side Story). In the summer of 2000, she was the musical director and voice teacher for STAR, Capital Repertory Theater’s youth theater program. Laurie has previously directed HMT’s Theater for Families production of CHARLOTTE’S WEB, Conservatory musical productions of ALADDIN, Jr., ANNIE, Jr., SEUSSICAL Jr., FIDDLER, Jr. and last season’s BEAUTY AND THE BEAST, Jr.

Home Made Theater is pleased to announce open registration for children and teens ages 11-18 years old for the HMT Youth Theater Conservatory production of THOROUGHLY MODERN MILLIE, JR. Taking place in New York City in 1922, THOROUGHLY MODERN MILLIE tells the story of young Millie Dillmount, who has just moved to the city in search of a new life for herself. It's a New York full of intrigue and jazz - a time when women were entering the workforce and the rules of love and social behavior were changing forever. HMT's conservatory program gives kids an exciting, creative and supportive environment in which to experience the thrill and exhilaration of performing in a main stage production. All students who register will be cast in our production of THOROUGHLY MODERN MILLIE, JR. to be performed at the Spa Little Theater. Performances will be open to friends, family, and the general public. No experience is necessary; children of all levels and experience are welcome. Dance/Tap experience is a plus.

Registration Fee is \$260.

Rehearsals will begin Saturday, March 20th and run Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:30-6:30pm and Saturdays from 9:00am-2:00pm. A lunch break will be given on Saturdays. On Saturday, March 20th rehearsal will be from 9AM to noon only. Rehearsals will not be scheduled during school vacation (April 5-9). There will be a week of dress rehearsals Monday, May 10th through Thursday, May 13th. All rehearsals will be held at the Spa Little Theater.

Performances are scheduled for Friday, May 14th at 7:30pm and Saturday, May 15th at 1:00pm & 4:30pm. Tickets are \$10 for adults & \$5 for children ages 12 & under. Seating is by general admission. Tickets will be available for purchase beginning Monday, April 26th.

Otherwise, registrations may be taken over the phone using MasterCard or Visa through the Home Made Theater office at 518-587-4427. Please send in one registration form per child. Please note that the conservatory normally fills prior to the registration deadline.
